Explanations and Definitions:

For some events, only some students will be participating. In these cases we indicate the participating students in italics, e.g. = (*Advanced Groups*). Events without these indications are open to all students.

Who is in each group?

- Beginning Band=*students who are enrolled in 6th Grade Band or Beginning Band.*
- Advanced Concert Band or Intermediate Concert Band=*students enrolled in Intermediate Band. The students will audition each semester and are placed into one of these two groups.*
- Beginning Strings=*students who are enrolled in Beginning Orchestra or 6th Grade Orchestra.*
- Advanced Strings=*students who are enrolled in Intermediate Orchestra, and some selected students from the Beginning Strings.*
- Concert Orchestra=*students in the Advanced Strings, and selected students from the Advanced Concert Band.*
- Beginning Groups=*students in the Beginning Band and Beginning Strings.*
- Advanced Groups=*students in the Advanced Concert Band, Intermediate Concert Band and Advanced Strings.*
- Tri-M=*an honor society made up of student officers and other selected students. See Handbook for more details.*
- Winter Guard=*a club in which students in the music department may participate. See Handbook for more details.*
- Parents=*Parents, and community volunteers.*

Mandatory events are graded school-sponsored concerts, and the Parade of Bands/Orchestra. Specifically these are: Winter Concert, Feeder School Concert Tours, Kahala Mall Concert, Ala Moana Concert, KMS Band Spring Concert, Kalani/Niu Valley/KMS Orchestra Spring Concert, HASTA Parade of Orchestras, OBDA Advanced Intermediate Parade of Bands, OBDA Beginning and Intermediate Parade of Bands, and Aloha Concert. Other events are optional and not graded.

Winter Concert and Aloha Concerts are end-of-semester concerts that feature all performing groups.

Feeder School Concert Tours are concerts that are performed at the elementary schools that send students to Kaimuki Middle School. The Advanced Concert Band and Advanced Strings perform together in December. Usually a total of six elementary schools are visited during two school days.

Kahala Mall Concert and Ala Moana Concert are concerts performed in those shopping centers. The Concert Orchestra will perform at Kahala Mall, and the Advanced Concert Band will perform at Ala Moana.

Spring Concerts are concerts that are performed in April, and may be with other schools (as indicated).

OBDA Parade of Bands and HASTA Parade of Orchestras is a showcase of several school bands and orchestras. It is not a “parade” such as the Macy’s Thanksgiving Day Parade. All groups will perform at their respective event.

OBDA=O’ahu Band Directors Association. This association provides educational opportunities for music students participating in their school band with a band director who is a member of this organization.

HASTA=Hawai’i American String Teachers Association. This association provides educational opportunities for music students who are studying under a string teacher who is a member of this organization.
